The main problem with the previous one was it was three weeks old before it was given out. Anyway Phil chickened out in the end, I think he's waiting to do a piece for a new wave gig so he can have a right old go. When ever I see him he always says "When are you going to get some decent bands at the Gardens?" I bet quite a few of you of you here tonite are uttering the same sentiments! Well in my book since March 1977 we've had three punk gigs in one year, The Damned Ultravox and the Jam. I don't consider Eddie and the Hot Rods, Stranglers Rich Kids or T.R.B. as punk bands.
