Fush Dada. Fush Dada. FUSH DADA.

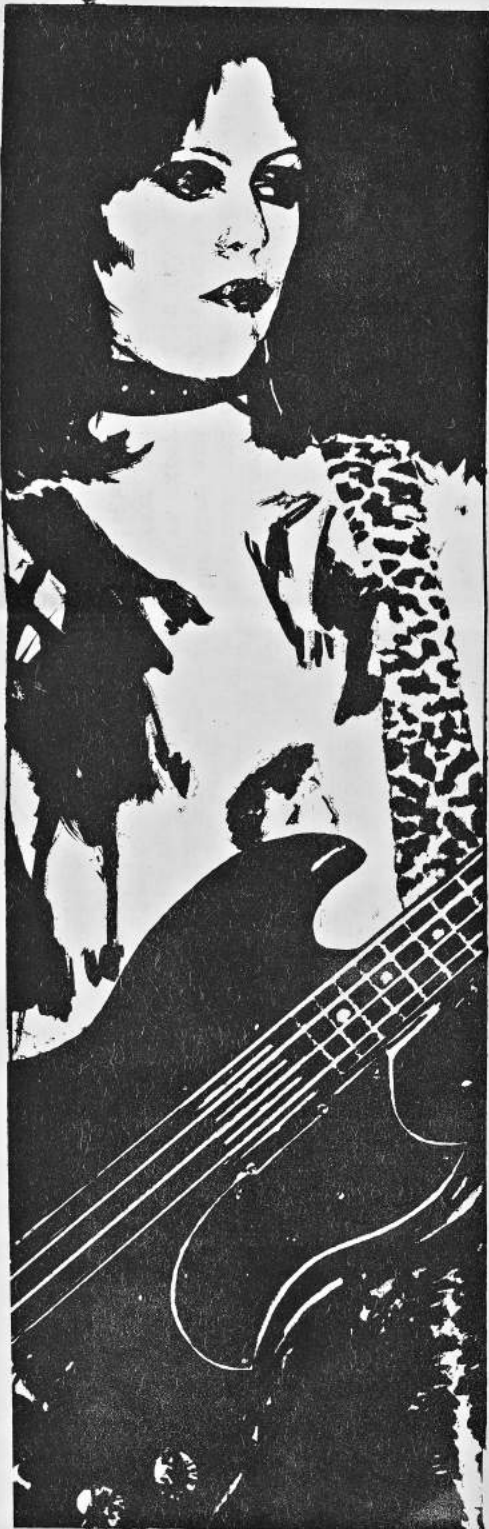
